Title

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AN ORDINANCE
Amending The Business License Ordinance
Provisions For Insurance Companies and
For Brokers For Non-admitted Fire and Casualty Insurers

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City/Town of 2004-1007, that the Business License Ordinance is amended by changing the provisions for insurance companies and for brokers for non-admitted fire and casualty insurers to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

Insurance Companies: Except as to fire insurance, "gross premiums" means gross premiums collected (1) on policies on property or risks located in the municipality, and (2) on policies, wherever the insured property or risk is located, that are sold, solicited, negotiated, taken, transmitted, received, delivered, applied for, produced or serviced by the insurance company's office located in the municipality or by the insurance company's employee doing business within the municipality or by the office of the insurance company's licensed or appointed producer (agent) located in the municipality or by the insurance company's licensed or appointed producer (agent) doing business within the municipality. As to fire insurance, "gross premiums" means gross premiums (1) collected in the municipality, and/or (2) realized from risks located within the limits of the municipality.

Gross premiums shall include new and renewal business without deductions for any dividend, credit, return premiums or deposit.

Solicitation for insurance, receiving or transmitting an application or policy, examination of a risk, collection or transmitting of a premium, adjusting a claim, delivering a benefit, or doing any act in connection with a policy or claim shall constitute doing business within the municipality whether or not an office is maintained therein. A premium collected on property or a risk located within the municipality shall be deemed to have been collected within the municipality. Declining rates shall not apply.

6411 524210 Brokers for Fire and Casualty Insurers - Non-admitted:
 As to brokers for non-admitted fire and casualty insurers, "gross premiums" means gross premiums collected by or for fire and casualty insurers not licensed in South Carolina (1) on policies on property or risks located in the municipality and/or (2) on policies, wherever the insured property or risk is located, that are sold, solicited, negotiated, taken, transmitted, received, delivered,

applied for, produced or serviced by a broker located in or doing business within the municipality. Brokers shall provide, with their payment of the tax, a copy of the report required by the State Department of Insurance showing the locations of the property or risks insured. 2% of Gross Premiums [Premiums for non-admitted business are not included in broker's gross commissions for other business. Declining rates shall not apply.]

SECTION 2.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this ordinance, license taxes for insurance companies and brokers for non-admitted fire and casualty insurers shall be payable on or before May 31 in each year without penalty. The penalty for delinquent payments shall be 5% of the tax due per month, or portion thereof, after the due date until paid.

SECTION 3.


Any exemptions in the business license ordinance for income from business in interstate commerce are hereby repealed. Gross income from interstate commerce shall be included in the gross income for every business subject to a business license tax.

SECTION 4.

The Agreement with the Municipal Association of South Carolina, pursuant to S. C. Code section 5-7-300, for collection of current and delinquent license taxes from insurance companies and brokers for non-admitted fire and casualty insurers shall continue in effect.



ORDINANCE NO. 2004-0911
AMENDING THE BUSINESS LICENSE ORDINANCE
LEVYING A BUSINESS LICENSE TAX ON RETAIL
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code sections 58-9-2200 through 58-9-2270, effective June 30, 1999, provide for municipal business license taxes on "retail telecommunications services" as defined and limited therein; and

WHEREAS, the South Carolina General Assembly, on June 3, 2004, ratified an act (Rat # 0406) amending S.C. Code sections 58-9-2200, 58-9-2220, and 58-9-2230, that will take effect upon approval by the Governor, and that, among other things, authorizes municipalities, for business license tax years beginning after 2003, to levy a maximum business license tax on the gross income derived from the sale of retail telecommunications services for the preceding calendar or fiscal year at the rate of one percent; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Business License Ordinance to conform to the State law as amended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City/Town of West Pelzer, S.C., that the Business License Ordinance is amended as follows:

Section 1.

a. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Business License Ordinance, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services", as defined in S. C. Code section 58-9-2200, shall be at the maximum rate authorized by S. C. Code section 58-9-2220, as it now provides or as provided by its amendment. The business license tax year shall begin on January 1 of each year. The rate for the 2005 business license tax year shall be the maximum rate allowed by State law as in effect on February 1, 2005. Declining rates shall not apply.

b. In conformity with S.C. Code section 58-9-2220, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall apply to the gross income derived from the sale of retail telecommunications services for the preceding calendar or fiscal year which either originate or terminate in the municipality and which are charged to a service address within the municipality regardless of where these amounts are billed or paid and on which a business license tax has not been paid to another municipality. The measurement of the amounts derived from the retail sale of mobile telecommunications services shall include only revenues from the fixed monthly recurring charge of customers whose service address is within the boundaries of the municipality. For a business in operation for less than one year, the amount of business license tax shall be computed on a twelve-month projected income.

Section 2.

a. For the year 2005, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall be due on February 1, 2005, and payable by February 28, 2005, without penalty. For years after 2005, the business license tax for "retail telecommunications services" shall be due on January 1 of each year and payable by January 31 of that year, without penalty.

b. The delinquent penalty shall be five percent (5 %) of the tax due for each month, or portion thereof, after the due date until paid.

Section 3.

Exemptions in the business license ordinance for income from business in interstate commerce are hereby repealed. Properly apportioned gross income from interstate commerce shall be included in the gross income for every business subject to a business license tax.

Section 4.

a. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be interpreted to interfere with continuing obligations of any franchise agreement or contractual agreement in the event that the franchise or contractual agreement should expire after December 31, 2003.

b. All fees collected under such a franchise or contractual agreement expiring after December 31, 2003, shall be in lieu of fees or taxes which might otherwise be authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 5.

As authorized by S. C. Code section 5-7-300, the Agreement with the Municipal Association of South Carolina for collection of current and delinquent license taxes from telecommunications companies pursuant to S. C. Code section 58-9-2200 shall continue in effect. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Agreement, for the year 2005, the Municipal Association of South Carolina is authorized to collect current and delinquent license taxes, in conformity with the due date and delinquent date for 2005 as set out in this Ordinance and is further authorized, for the year 2005, to disburse business license taxes collected, less the service charge agreed to, to this municipality on or before April 1, 2005, and thereafter as remaining collections permit.

Section 6.

All previous ordinances, or portions of ordinances, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of final reading.



2.105-D DISCRETIONARY FUNDS/MAYOR AND COUNCIL

The Mayor and Council authorize to set aside funds in the amount of \$200.00 each, per year, for the purpose of assisting fellow citizens of West Pelzer. Reasons to use this fund will vary by request and must be discussed at the Town Council Meetings and voted on by Mayor and Council. All appropriations shall be made by check with two signatures, and shall be accounted for with receipts, etc. by the next meeting date. A member of Council is to be assigned to oversee this fund with monthly updates of what funds have been used. This amount must be included in the yearly budget. Council will decide who oversees this account and must choose a new "Oversight" person each year, each time that the new budget is adopted.

Any chapter, article, section or subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason declared to be unconstitutionally or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.



(AMENDMENT TO CODE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN

SECTION 1. Section 8.501 of the Town Code is hereby amended by adopting the following changes to business license fees:

Businesses will pay a \$50.00 minimum fee for gross sales up to \$10,000.00. For every thousand dollars above that amount, the fee is hereby changed from .50 to \$1.00 per thousand. Non-resident business owners are required to pay double the base amount. The \$50.00 solid waste fee that is collected for the county is still in effect, therefore, any place of business within the city limits must pay the solid waste fee on top of their business license fees. Businesses without a physical location in the city limits are not required to pay the solid waste fee.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any chapter, article, section or subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LOCAL MATCH FOR THE
CDBG COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Town of West Pelzer is suffering from undersized and malfunctioning water lines, which are currently creating health and environmental problems for its residents; and

WHEREAS, an opportunity exists for the Town of West Pelzer to aid its residents, especially the low to moderate income residents, by applying for a Community Infrastructure Grant from the SC Department of Commerce, Grants Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Community Infrastructure Grant would be used to replace and upgrade public water service throughout the Town of West Pelzer, which is majority low to moderate income; and

WHEREAS, the Town of West Pelzer must commit to a \$50,000.00 local match in order to receive a Community Infrastructure Grant, and any costs over the \$500,000.00 covered by the grant;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town of West Pelzer will commit the \$50,000.00 match to the West Pelzer Town-wide Water Project, for the payment of costs associated with the project, if the Community Infrastructure Grant is awarded to the Town. The Town of West Pelzer also commits to the payment of any other costs associated with the project that are over the \$550,000.00 covered by the grant and the local match.

(AMENDMENT TO CODE #2.406-2.419)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF WEST PELZER, SOUTH CAROLINA.

SECTION 1. _____ Town Code is hereby amended by adopting the following changes to Employment policies:

Resolution #R2004-01

A resolution seeking the aid of Anderson County Environmental Services; Wastewater Division, the Anderson County Administrator and others to assist the Town of West Pelzer in acquiring \$2.5 million dollars in funds for a sewer collection system replacement project for the Town of West Pelzer.

WHEREAS, the Town of West Pelzer operates a municipal utility system that is monitored under state and federal laws and regulations; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of West Pelzer along with other wastewater service providers will be required to meet increasingly stringent NPDES wastewater discharge limits or face penalties; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of West Pelzer is currently operating its wastewater system under a South Carolina DHEC Consent Order that compels the town to discontinue its wastewater treatment system, to incur a long-term debt and to connect to the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority and to pay for their services; and,

WHEREAS, the entire Town of West Pelzer serviced by the Town of West Pelzer with water distribution, sewer collection and treatment, and other services has in the past been designated as a low-to-moderate income area with many senior citizens; and,

WHEREAS, due to an aging sewer collection system nearing the end of its useful life, that will eventually require extensive, costly repairs or replacement, estimated to be \$2.5 million dollars; and,

WHEREAS, The Town of West Pelzer town council, acting by and through its authority now desires to seek, approve, and endorse the assistance from Anderson County Environmental Services; Wastewater Division, the Anderson County Administrator, and others to aid the town with acquiring federal funding as a line item appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town of West Pelzer Council in meeting duly assembled that:

1. The Town of West Pelzer's Council, acting as a body politic and as the official representatives of the people of West Pelzer, hereby expresses its approval of and its desire for the Town of West Pelzer to be assisted in a request for a line item appropriation from Congressman Greshan Barret (R-SC); that such assistance from Anderson County is in the best interests of West Pelzer, Anderson County, the State of South Carolina, and the environment. The Town of West Pelzer's Council further requests the Anderson County Council support such an assistance from Congressman Barrett.

2. All orders and resolutions in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict only, repealed and rescinded.

3. Should any part or portion of this resolution be deemed unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect the remainder hereof, all of which is hereby deemed seperable.

4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon enactment.
