2005-0107 PROPERTY ANNEXATION OF SAV-WAY
110 HIGHWAY 20, PELZER, SOUTH CAROLINA

Be it observed that the above Ordinance for Annexation of Property pertains to parcel located at 110 Hwy. 20, West Pelzer, South Carolina. Property owner, Kimberly Perry, has submitted a petition form for annexation and parcel has been verified as contiguous territory to the City limits of West Pelzer, South Carolina. This ordinance shall become effective as soon hereafter second reading as possible, pursuant to SC Code Section 5-3-150(3).

ORDINANCE #2005-0119
AGREEMENT FOR POLICE SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WEST
PELZER

WHEREAS, The Town of West Pelzer currently maintains a full-time police department with law enforcement officers certified by the State of South Carolina to enforce the State Laws and City Ordinances within the municipal boundaries of the Town of West Pelzer; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pelzer does not maintain a police department within the corporate limits of the Town of Pelzer and currently relies solely for law enforcement through the Anderson County Sheriff's Office; and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of both the Town of West Pelzer and the Town of Pelzer to enter into an agreement whereby the Town of West Pelzer will provide law enforcement services to the Town of Pelzer; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and legal sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Town of West Pelzer and the Town of Pelzer, do hereby agree as follows:

1. The Town of Pelzer shall grant jurisdiction to the Town of West Pelzer for the purpose of allowing West Pelzer Law Enforcement officers to patrol the streets of Pelzer for the protection of the citizens of the Town of Pelzer and shall further grant to the law enforcement officers of the Town of West Pelzer the jurisdiction and authority to enforce the laws of the State of South Carolina and within the corporate limits of the Town of Pelzer.
2. The Town of West Pelzer will provide law enforcement services to the Town of Pelzer through regular police patrols within the corporate limits of the Town of Pelzer and shall provide law enforcement services by way of enforcement of the laws of the State of South Carolina.
3. The Town of West Pelzer will provide the Town of Pelzer routine patrol by the West Pelzer police officers on the same schedule that they are patrolling West Pelzer.
4. The West Pelzer Police Department will provide emergency services and protection on an on-call or notified basis.
5. The officers will remain under the direct supervision and control of the Town of West Pelzer.


6. The Town of Pelzer will notify its liability insurance carrier and take appropriate measures to provide liability insurance coverage for the actions of the officers while patrolling the Town of Pelzer.
7. The Town of West Pelzer will continue to maintain at least its existing liability insurance coverage, as well as all worker's compensation insurance coverage.
8. The Town of West Pelzer will retain direct responsibility for payment to the police officers, including salary, insurance, etc.
9. In the event that any arrests for violation of said laws are made by the law enforcement officers of the Town of West Pelzer, those persons arrested shall be transported to the Anderson County Detention Center and prosecution shall be through the Anderson County Magistrate's Court system until such time as jurisdiction for any such prosecutions shall be granted to the West Pelzer Municipal Court.
10. Both West Pelzer and Pelzer agree that this agreement shall be modified to provide for prosecution for all such arrests through the West Pelzer Municipal Court system as soon as jurisdiction for same is conferred upon that court system.
11. The terms of this agreement shall be for a period of six (6) months from the date of the signing hereof.
12. The Town of Pelzer shall pay to the Town of West Pelzer the sum of \$1500.00 for the services rendered during the period of this contract, payable on a monthly basis, due upon the first of each month. Automatic renewal of this contract will be in effect unless either party submits a written request thirty days before renewal date arrives.

This Ordinance shall supercede and replace Ordinance #2004-0910 which was enacted previously by the Mayor and Council of the Town of West Pelzer, and which is now rendered void with the enactment of this Ordinance.


