APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES September 13, 2022 Council Meeting Councilman Lee made a motion to approve, 2nd by Councilwoman Alexander; all were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 2022-1114 "Appointment of Municipal Court Judge"

Clerk's comments: A selection committee was appointed to interview and make recommendations to Council; Per this resolution the committee recommends the appointment of Stephen Turner for a four-year term commencing on January 15, 2023 and ending January 14, 2027. Councilman Lee stated that this was not taken lightly by himself or Councilman Riddle and they believed they made the most reasonable decision for the Town. Councilman Lee made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-1114, 2nd by Councilman Rogers; Councilwoman Alexander abstained. Mayor Sanders, Councilman Lee and Councilman Rogers were in favor; motion passed. Mayor Sanders thanked Judge Cole for her service and stated that there was no better choice to take us through the transition period. Judge Cole will continue to serve as Municipal Judge through mid-January. As a County Magistrate she will continue to assist our agency moving forward.

Ordinance 2021-1011.1 "Adoption of International Building Codes Per SC Law"

Clerk's comments: All building codes used within the State shall be adopted by the Council and enforced by local jurisdictions; ordinance requires two readings; second reading will be schedule for December 2022. Mayor Sanders added that this was just a formality since the international building codes is adopted statewide. Mayor Sanders made a motion to approve first reading of Ordinance 2022-1114.1, 2nd by Councilman Lee; all were in favor.

RESOLUTION 2022-1114

APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS; West Pelzer Town Code provides for the establishment of a Municipal Court and the appointment of a Municipal Judge; and

WHEREAS; a selection committee was appointed to interview and make recommendations to Council; and

WHEREAS; the selection committee has determined that based on his years of experience with small-town criminal justice, Stephen Turner will have a practical, common sense approach to interpreting municipal codes and their enforcement; and

WHEREAS; the selection committee has determined that Stephen Turner has the mindset and approach to best serve and protect the citizens of West Pelzer; and

WHEREAS; the selection committee recommends the appointment of Stephen Turner as parttime Municipal Judge for a term of four years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the West Pelzer Town Council that Stephen Turner is hereby appointed West Pelzer Municipal Judge for a term of four years commencing on January 15, 2023 and ending January 14, 2027.

ORDINANCE 2021-1114.1 Adoption of International Building Codes Per SC Law

Section 1: General

- (A) All building codes used within the State shall be adopted by the Council and enforced by local jurisdictions. The adoption process must follow the procedure established in the Building Codes Act and be completed prior to January 1, 2023.
- (B) Administration and enforcement of the latest adopted edition of any building code must occur in all local jurisdictions on the implementation date as established by the Council. All new construction, additions, renovations, repair, or work of any kind, to any system, in a building or structure, for which a completed building permit application has been approved prior to the implementation date, will be allowed to be completed and must be inspected under the building codes in effect at the time the original building permit was issued.
- (C) Council hereby adopts the following mandated adopted codes:
 - 2021 International Building Code with SC Modifications
 - 2021 International Residential Code with SC Modifications
 - 2021 International Plumbing Code with SC Modifications
 - 2021 International Mechanical Code with SC Modifications
 - 2021 International Fuel Gas Code with SC Modifications
 - 2021 International Fire Code with SC Modifications
 - 2020 NFPA 70 National Electrical Code
